



Water Rates



This schedule of rates and charges applies to Evansville Water and Sewer Utility customers and supersedes previous schedules issued.

Monthly Service Charge

The monthly service charge is based on meter size.

Volume Charge

In addition to the monthly service charge set forth above, each Residential, Commercial, Industrial, and Public Authority user will pay a monthly usage charge according to the following schedule:

Water Consumption	Rate Per 1,000 Gallons
First 20,000 gallons	\$6.84
Next 280,000 gallons	\$5.34
Next 700,000 gallons	\$4.82
Next 2,000,000 gallons	\$4.25
Over 3,000,000 gallons	\$3.21

Fire Protection Surcharge

The monthly surcharge for fire protection is based on the meter size and the customer's location — inside or outside City limits.

Bills for water service not paid before the stated due date are subject to the collection or deferred payment charge of 10% up to the first \$3 of the delinquent payment, plus 3% for the remaining delinquent amount more than \$3.
